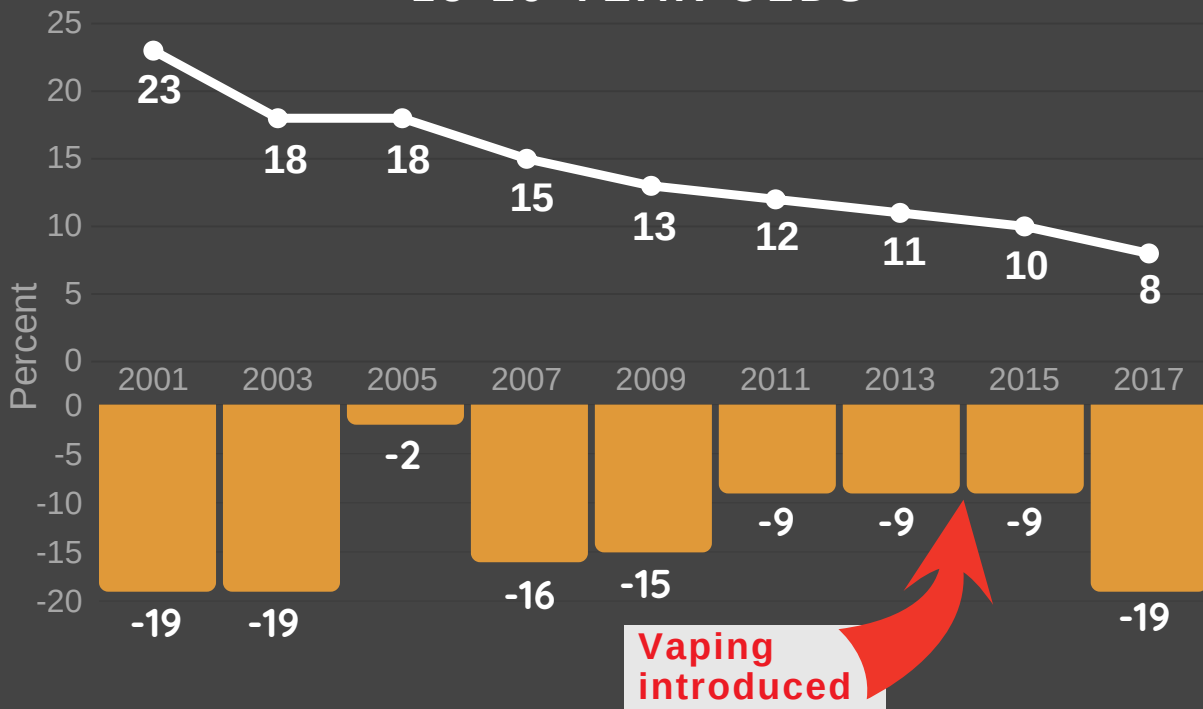

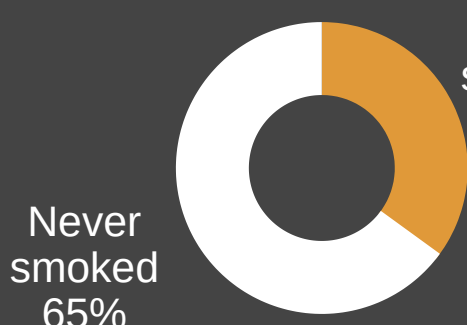
DIFFERENCE IN SMOKING RATES OVER 2 YEAR PERIODS (%)

15-19 YEAR OLDS



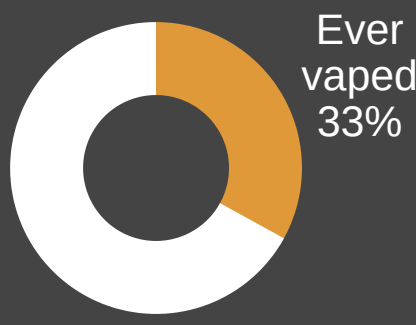
AFTER 6 YEARS OF THE SAME RATE DECREASE,
